Hotel Room Suicide & Blessing

In the middle of October I was called out to a tragic suicide at a hotel in the area. The hotel staff found the deceased after the individual failed to check out. As you can imagine this is very traumatic for the employees who found the deceased. I spent some time with the staff, who at the time, didn't want to talk much. Sensing they needed some time to process this, I gave them my business card and made sure they knew they could call me at anytime if they needed anything.

A day later I received a call from the hotel manager, who was one of three employees at the scene. She said the room was being sanitized and she wondered if I could come by the next day and pray a blessing over the room. I called up my home church, Grace Chapel, and requested a team member of their Ministry Response Team to attend with me.

Using anointing oil I placed a cross on the top of the door frame as my team mate and five hotel employees entered the room. We had a brief discussion about what happened and then I began to pray over the room, the hotel, and the employees. It seemed some of the five employees did not have faith, but I continue to pray that a seed was planted in their hearts that day. I feel honored that through your partnership, I am able to minister in to the community at large. Together we can be the hands and feet of Jesus to a largely secular population.
